## **Get Ready for Hummingbird Season!**

Those sweet little birds are making their way back to WNC now and have been reported to travel up to 23 miles a day! Our RR neighbor Sharon Owens shared this hummingbird migration map with our group. It looks like they have been spotted in Knoxville and Greenville so far.
